Dear Mr. Adler:

This letter responds to the administrative appeals you submitted to the Mayor under the District of Columbia Freedom of Information Act, D.C. Official Code § 2-537 (“DC FOIA”), challenging the failure of the District of Columbia Public Schools (“DCPS”) to respond to your FOIA requests in FOIA Appeals 2020-055 and 2020-056. In FOIA Appeal 2020-055, you requested correspondence between DCPS and a specific school regarding an attic renovation project. In FOIA Appeal 2020-056, you requested the results of a survey. You indicated that both appeals were based on the failure of DCPS to respond to the FOIA requests. On December 20, 2019, you withdrew your appeals by email confirming that you had received the requested information.

Based on the confirmation from you that the appeals have been withdrawn, these two appeals are now moot and are hereby dismissed. This constitutes the final decision of this Office. You are free to challenge MPD’s substantive response by separate appeal to this Office. If you are dissatisfied with this decision, you may commence a civil action against the District of Columbia in the Superior Court of the District of Columbia in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 2-537.
