This letter responds to the administrative appeal you submitted to the Mayor under the District of Columbia Freedom of Information Act, D.C. Code § 2-537 (“DC FOIA”), challenging the failure of the Department of Employment Services (“DOES”) to properly respond to your FOIA request. You sent an email to this Office confirming that the appeal has been withdrawn because you received a response from DOES. However, you may file a new request once you have had an opportunity to review the records provided by DOES. We therefore dismiss this appeal as moot.

This constitutes the final decision of this Office. If you are dissatisfied with this decision, you may commence a civil action against the District of Columbia in the Superior Court of the District of Columbia in accordance with D.C. Code § 2-537.
