Dear Mr. Slate:

This letter responds to the administrative appeal you submitted to the Mayor under the District of Columbia Freedom of Information Act, D.C. Code § 2-537 (“DC FOIA”), challenging the failure of the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (“ABRA”) to properly respond to your FOIA requests.

You initially submitted two requests, 2020-FOIA-02693 and 2020-FOIA-03382, seeking various records related to the Dew Drop Inn, which ABRA ultimately provided. However, ABRA did not provide you with a video you had sought which was responsive to your requests.

ABRA has informed our office that it is not denying your request for the video in question and that it will communicate directly with you to schedule a time to retrieve the video on a thumb drive.¹ Because ABRA is already making arrangements to provide you with the video that you are seeking on appeal, we dismiss this appeal as moot.

This constitutes the final decision of this Office. If you are dissatisfied with this decision, you may commence a civil action against the District of Columbia in the Superior Court of the District of Columbia in accordance with D.C. Code § 2-537.
