Dear Ms. Mohsen:

This letter responds to the administrative appeal you submitted to the Mayor under the District of Columbia Freedom of Information Act, D.C. Code § 2-537 (“DC FOIA”). In your appeal, you challenge the response you received from the Office of Unified Communications (“OUC”) regarding your request for public records under DC FOIA.

You submitted a DC FOIA request to the OUC seeking recordings of 911 calls related to a specified incident report. OUC produced records to you in response to that request. You later filed an appeal with this Office and requested that OUC produce additional records to you. OUC responded to your appeal¹ on March 23, 2020, and provided you with the additional records you requested.

As your appeal was based on OUC’s failure to produce the additional records you requested, and the agency has now provided you the requested records, we consider your appeal to be moot and hereby dismiss it. This constitutes the final decision of this Office. If you are dissatisfied with this decision, you may commence a civil action against the District of Columbia in the Superior Court of the District of Columbia in accordance with D.C. Code § 2-537.
