Dear Mr. Partlow:

This letter responds to the administrative appeal you submitted to the Mayor under the District of Columbia Freedom of Information Act, D.C. Code § 2-537 (“DC FOIA”), challenging the redactions made by the Office of Unified Communications (“OUC”) in response to your FOIA request number 2020-FOIA-01909.

You initially requested that OUC provide you with “[a]ll documents showing calls for service at the Trump International Hotel Washington DC from 1/1/2017 to the present” as well as “[a]ll documents showing calls of service where the location is listed as 1100 Pennsylvania Ave NW, Washington, DC 20004.” OUC provided you with the requested documents but made certain redactions for personal privacy, citing D.C. Code §2-534(a)(2). This appeal followed.

In response to your appeal, OUC again reviewed the documents you requested and subsequently determined that releasing the redacted information would not impose on any person’s right to privacy. Based on this new determination, on June 25, 2020, OUC provided you with the entirety of the information you requested.<sup>1</sup> Because OUC has now provided you with the unredacted versions of the documents you are seeking on appeal, we dismiss this appeal as moot.

This constitutes the final decision of this Office. If you are dissatisfied with this decision, you may commence a civil action against the District of Columbia in the Superior Court of the District of Columbia in accordance with D.C. Code § 2-537.
