Dear Ms. Jablow:

This letter responds to the administrative appeal you submitted to the Mayor under the District of Columbia Freedom of Information Act, D.C. Code § 2-537 ("DC FOIA"), challenging the failure by the District of Columbia Public Schools ("DCPS") to respond to your FOIA request number 2020-FOIA-03078.

You initially requested documents related to computers provided to DCPS students. When DCPS failed to respond to your request, you filed this appeal. In response to your appeal, DCPS granted your request in full.<sup>1</sup> Because DCPS has responded to your request and provided you with the documents you sought, we dismiss this appeal as moot.

This constitutes the final decision of this Office. If you are dissatisfied with this decision, you may commence a civil action against the District of Columbia in the Superior Court of the District of Columbia in accordance with D.C. Code § 2-537.
