Dear Ms. Spindel:

This letter is in response to the administrative appeal that you have submitted to the Mayor pursuant to the District of Columbia Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), D.C. Code §§ 2-531, *et seq.* In your appeal, you have challenged the lack of response of the Child and Family Services Agency ("CFSA") to your September 2, 2020 FOIA request, identified as 2020-FOIA-07643, which sought the following:

[A]ll contracts between CFSA/DC Govt and the DC Family Success Centers, as well as all submissions by the Success Centers regarding what services they will provide to DC residents.

A review of the District's FOIA-tracking data indicates CFSA granted your request on October 18, 2021.

Because you have only challenged CFSA's failure to respond, we dismiss this appeal as moot. However, you are free to challenge any substantive response received from CFSA by separate appeal to this Office

This constitutes the final decision of this Office. If you are dissatisfied with this decision, you may commence a civil action against the District of Columbia government in the Superior Court of the District of Columbia.
