Dear Ms. Nahas:

This letter is in response to the administrative appeal that you have submitted to the Mayor pursuant to the District of Columbia Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), D.C. Code §§ 2-531, *et seq.* In your appeal, you have challenged the lack of response of the Metropolitan Police Department ("MPD") to your November 9, 2020 FOIA request, identified as 2021-FOIA-01001, which sought a copy of "Arrest #627315-Police Report #09/113249."

It is noted the aforementioned request is one of three seeking the same information. The others include 2021-FOIA-02129 and 2021-FOIA-02449.

The District's FOIA-tracking data indicates MPD granted your request, in part, and denied it, in part, on February 19, 2021, in response to 2021-FOIA-02129.

Because you have only challenged MPD's failure to respond and it appears MPD has responded to your request, we dismiss this appeal as moot.

This constitutes the final decision of this Office. However, you are free to challenge any substantive response received from MPD by separate appeal to this Office. If you are dissatisfied with this decision, you may commence a civil action against the District of Columbia government in the Superior Court of the District of Columbia.
