Dear Mr. Maxwell:

This letter responds to the administrative appeal you submitted to the Mayor under the District of Columbia Freedom of Information Act, D.C. Official Code § 2-537 (“DC FOIA”), challenging the lack of response from the Metropolitan Police Department (“MPD”) to your DC FOIA request, identified as 2020-BWC-00279, which sought body and/or camera footage related to CCN#20120700.

The District’s FOIA-tracking data indicates MPD granted your request, in part, and denied it, in part, on February 19, 2021.

Because you have only challenged MPD’s failure to respond and it appears MPD has responded to your request, we dismiss this appeal as moot.

This constitutes the final decision of this Office. However, you are free to challenge any substantive response received from MPD by separate appeal to this Office. If you are dissatisfied with this decision, you may commence a civil action against the District of Columbia government in the Superior Court of the District of Columbia in accordance with DC FOIA.
