Dear Ms. Harris:

This letter responds to the administrative appeal you submitted to the Mayor under the District of Columbia Freedom of Information Act, D.C. Code § 2-537 (“DC FOIA”), challenging a lack of response from the District’s Department of Human Resources (“DCHR”) to your DC FOIA request.

You submitted a DC FOIA request to DCHR seeking various documents and posing questions related to a vacancy announcement. When DCHR did not respond to your request, you appealed to this Office. Subsequent to your appeal, DCHR confirmed to this Office that it contacted you and provided a response to your DC FOIA request.¹

Because DCHR has now responded to your request, we dismiss this appeal as moot. If you would like to challenge any aspect of the agency’s response to your request, you are free to file a new appeal with this Office.

This constitutes the final decision of this Office. If you are dissatisfied with this decision, you may commence a civil action against the District of Columbia in the Superior Court of the District of Columbia in accordance with D.C. Code § 2-537.
