Dear Mr. Fakri:

This letter responds to the administrative appeal you submitted to the Mayor under the District of Columbia Freedom of Information Act, D.C. Official Code § 2-537 (“DC FOIA”), challenging the failure by the D.C. Fire and Emergency Medical Services Department (“FEMS”) to respond to your FOIA request number 2021-FOIA-03011.

You requested a copy of the fire incident report for a particular address. You filed an appeal on March 15, 2021, claiming you had not received a response to your FOIA request. On March 17, 2021, FEMS filed a response to your appeal.<sup>1</sup> In the response, FEMS indicated that it sent you the responsive document on February 17, 2021 and when you inquired about your request on March 2, 2021, agreed to resend the document if you could not find it in your inbox. Because FEMS has responded to your request and provided you with the document you sought, we dismiss this appeal as moot.

This constitutes the final decision of this Office. If you are dissatisfied with this decision, you may commence a civil action against the District of Columbia government in the Superior Court of the District of Columbia in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 2-537.
