Dear Mr. Slate:

This letter responds to the administrative appeal you have submitted to the Mayor under the District of Columbia Freedom of Information Act, D.C. Official Code § 2-537 ("DC FOIA"). In your appeal, you have asserted the Metropolitan Police Department ("MPD") failed to respond to your DC FOIA request, identified as 2021-FOIA-03698, which sought the following:

[P]ublic records, including but not limited to police report, investigative notes, emails, or any other record that relates to, or involves yourself, D.K. (individual), T.F. (individual), 35 Bryant Street, NW, and 1708 Kilbourne Pl., NW.

On receipt of the notification of this appeal, MPD provided a copy of the May 7, 2021 response to the aforementioned FOIA request.

Because you only challenged MPD's failure to respond and it appears MPD has responded to your request, we dismiss this appeal as moot

This constitutes the final decision of this Office. If you are dissatisfied with this decision, you may commence a civil action against the District of Columbia in the Superior Court of the District of Columbia in accordance with D.C. Code § 2-537.
