Dear Mr. Slate:

This letter responds to the administrative appeal you submitted to the Mayor under the District of Columbia Freedom of Information Act, D.C. Code § 2-537 (“DC FOIA”), challenging the lack of response from the Executive Office of the Mayor (“EOM”) to your DC FOIA request.

You submitted a DC FOIA request to EOM seeking all public records relating to 3 specific individuals and 2 specific addresses. When EOM did not respond, you filed an appeal with this office. Following your appeal, as EOM explained in its response to this office, EOM conducted a search, and produced responsive records with some redactions for deliberative process, attorney-client privilege and personal privacy. EOM also withheld responsive records for deliberative process, attorney-client privilege and personal privacy.<sup>1</sup>

Because EOM has responded to your request and produced responsive records, we dismiss this appeal as moot. However, you may file a new appeal with this Office if you are dissatisfied with the agency’s response.

This constitutes the final decision of this Office. If you are dissatisfied with this decision, you may commence a civil action against the District of Columbia in the Superior Court of the District of Columbia in accordance with D.C. Code § 2-537.
