Dear Mr. Hedrick:

This letter responds to the administrative appeals you submitted to the Mayor under the District of Columbia Freedom of Information Act, D.C. Official Code § 2-537 (“DC FOIA”), on the grounds that the University of the District of Columbia (“UDC”) failed to respond to your DC FOIA request.

On October 26, 2021, you submitted a DC FOIA request seeking “any records, including emails, documents, memos, video, [and] photographs, pertaining to” yourself between June 1, 2021, to October 26, 2021.

You filed your appeal with this Office on December 31, 2021, because you had not received a response to your DC FOIA request. On January 31, 2022, UDC filed a response to your appeal.<sup>1</sup> In the response, UDC provided you with records responsive your request.

Since your appeal only challenged the failure of UDC to respond to your DC FOIA request and UDC has now responded to your request, we dismiss your appeal as moot. However, you may file a new appeal if you are dissatisfied with the agency’s response or the records produced.

This constitutes the final decision of this Office. If you are dissatisfied with this decision, you may commence a civil action against the District of Columbia government in the Superior Court of the District of Columbia in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 2-537.
