Dear Ms. Farley:

This letter responds to the administrative appeal you submitted to the Mayor under the District of Columbia Freedom of Information Act, D.C. Official Code § 2-537 ("DC FOIA"). In your appeal, you have challenged the lack of response from the Metropolitan Police Department ("MPD") to your DC FOIA request.

On November 23, 2021, on behalf of your client, you submitted a DC FOIA request to MPD, identified as 2022-BWC-00068, which sought body worn camera footage for a specific automobile accident (CCN# 21128093).

When MPD did not respond, you filed an appeal with this Office on January 25, 2022. On March 3, 2022, we notified MPD of your appeal and requested a response. MPD responded on September 30, 2022, explaining that, on February 10, 2022, it provided you with redacted footage and "a detailed response explaining the redactions made, the legal bases for those redactions, and [appeal rights]."

Because you only challenged MPD's failure to respond and it appears MPD has responded to your request, we dismiss this appeal as moot. However, you are free to challenge MPD's substantive response by separate appeal to this Office.

This constitutes the final decision of this Office. If you are dissatisfied with this decision, you may commence a civil action against the District of Columbia in Superior Court in accordance with D.C. Code § 2-537.
