Dear Ms. Konigsburg:

This letter is in response to the administrative appeal that you have submitted to the Mayor pursuant to the District of Columbia Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), D.C. Code §§ 2-531, *et seq.* In your March 21, 2022 appeal, you have challenged the lack of response of the Office of the Deputy Mayor for Public Safety & Justice ("DMPSJ") to your August 2, 2021 FOIA request, identified as 2021-FOIA-06999, which sought the following:

[A]ll records for the neighborhood in respect to Lewis Crowe Park at West Virginia and Mt. Olivet and Capitol Ave. NE. We are not getting help from government agencies so are requesting all records to understand what is going on at this location and why there is no attention to this park and our community is allowed to fester with crime.

A review of the District's FOIA-tracking data indicates DMPSJ granted your request in full on June 21, 2022.

Because you have only challenged DMPSJ failure to respond, we dismiss this appeal as moot. However, you are free to challenge any substantive response received from DMPSJ by separate appeal to this Office

This constitutes the final decision of this Office. If you are dissatisfied with this decision, you may commence a civil action against the District of Columbia government in Superior Court.
