Dear Mr. Fakri:

This letter responds to the administrative appeal you submitted to the Mayor under the District of Columbia Freedom of Information Act, D.C. Code § 2-537 (“DC FOIA”), challenging the lack of response from the Fire and Emergency Medical Services Department (“FEMS”) to your DC FOIA request.

On March 10, 2022, you submitted a DC FOIA request to FEMS seeking a copy of the incident report for a particular address. On April 6, 2022, you filed an appeal with this Office because FEMS had not responded to your request. On April 26, 2022, we notified FEMS of your appeal and requested a response. On April 28, 2022, FEMS responded. In its responses, FEMS explained that on April 7, 2022, the agency emailed you a responsive record with private citizens’ contact information withheld.

Because your appeal only challenged FEMS’ failure to respond and FEMS has provided you with the document you sought, we dismiss this appeal as moot.

This constitutes the final decision of this Office. If you are dissatisfied with this decision, you may commence a civil action against the District of Columbia in the Superior Court of the District of Columbia in accordance with D.C. Code § 2-537.
