Dear Ms. Dennis:

This letter is in response to the administrative appeal that you have submitted to the Mayor pursuant to the District of Columbia Freedom of Information Act, D.C. Code §§ 2-531, *et seq.* (“DC FOIA”). In your appeal, you have challenged the lack of response of the Metropolitan Police Department (“MPD”) to your March 29, 2022 DC FOIA request, identified as 2022-FOIA-04910, which sought the following:

... records of all reported repossessions to the MPD in the last ten years. [January 1, 2011-March 29, 2022.]

A review of the District’s FOIA-tracking data indicates MPD denied your request in full on July 12, 2022. Because you have only challenged MPD’s failure to respond, and MPD has responded, we dismiss this appeal as moot. However, you are free to challenge any substantive response received from MPD by separate appeal to this Office

This constitutes the final decision of this Office. If you are dissatisfied with this decision, you may commence a civil action against the District of Columbia government in Superior Court.
